From Gordon Mussett, Clerk to Little Braxted Parish Council:

When I wrote my piece on the VAS signs in Little Braxted I was unaware that, in addition to the paid speedwatch scheme operated by Maldon District Council, the Wickham Bishops Community Speedwatch Scheme also undertook regular checks. I would like to record my apologies to them.

Update from Maldon District Council

Along with my colleagues in Heybridge, we are still working get the speed reduced on Broad Street Green. This is particularly important as new residents move into the latest part of the development. We are also working with the developer and ECC to improve the condition of the footpath.

After putting in a local highways applications for speed reduction in Chapel Road and Mill Road, Essex Highways and the Local Highways Panel, have decided that this is not feasible or necessary, this is very disappointing and it continues ECC failure to deliver. At the moment the highways panel has no resources and due to a lack of funding from ECC so therefore the panels are unable to deliver any solutions.

The Government have confirmed a further UK Shared Prosperity Fund allocation for the Maldon District. The funding has made a real difference to the district and having a continuation of this fund gives the Council more opportunities to deliver a range of projects across the Maldon District for the benefit of our residents, visitors and businesses. I will let you know about the projects as details become available.

We have also announced the date for UFest community festival has been arranged for Friday 15 August 2025, following the success and positive feedback from last year's event at Promenade Park in Maldon.

The government has announced that there will be local government reform. The main consequence of this is that at some time in the future Maldon District will be part of a larger authority. We need to ensure that any new authority has a sense of place and locality. We will keep residents informed as proposals develop.


